Malcolm Wilson Rally postponed



The second round of the 2018 BTRDA series, the Malcolm Wilson Rally, has been postponed due to the severe weather conditions currently affecting the country.

The event had attracted over 90 entries and was scheduled to run on Saturday 3rd March, but is now to be rescheduled due to the difficult travelling conditions.

A statement from the organisers read: "The organisers can't guarantee the safe running of the event because of the weather and travelling conditions.

"We have therefore decided that it will be safer to postpone the event, with a suitable date now being sought.

"This decision has been made with great reluctance as rallying is about tackling weather conditions but simply getting to the event is not part of the competition."

Competitors and safety marshals will be updated later today.

Those worst affected by the news are those using the Malcolm Wilson as a warm-up to their British Rally Championship campaign.

They will now head to the Border Counties next week with little or no seat-time having also already lost a day's running in that event in circumstances unaffected by the weather.
